Antivirus Email Protection

As you all should know by now, Quicksilver launched our Antivirus email protection during December.

We're pleased to tell you that the Antivirus software has stopped an estimated 2730 viruses during the month of December.

Don't forget, on March 1st the antivirus protection will continue to be free for all customers who pay by Direct Debit, Regular Payments by Credit Card, or who are on 3, 6, or 12 month prepaid accounts. Other customers can pay \$2 per month to continue receiving the protection after March 1st.

Antivirus FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

How does it work?

The mail server scans each incoming email in your Quicksilver mailbox. When a virus is detected, the email is blocked and you will receive a notice by email.

Does Quicksilver scan my Hotmail email as well?

No. Quicksilver only scans incoming email for your Quicksilver mailbox.

Can I get rid of the Antivirus software installed on my computer?

We recommend you do keep Antivirus software installed on

your computer. Not all viruses come in through email, and Quicksilver cannot guarantee that all viruses will be detected on the mail server.

Can I switch it off if I don't want it?

Yes. Just give us a call or email help@quicksilver.co.nz
